APPLICATION PROCEDURE



Application of Wood Stains is usually done by cloth on raw wood/veneer. The cloth is soaked in the Wood Stains and applied over the wooden substrate, over multiple passes to obtain the desired colour strength. Wood Stains have fast drying solvents, so they dry very quickly and after that the sealer application can be initiated.

SURFACE PREPARATION

- Wood Stains are usually applied with a cloth soaked with stain directly on sanded raw wood to highlight the natural grain patterns.
- For colour homogenization in wood stains, it is customary to wipe the wet stain with a dry cloth, immediately after it is applied.
- Wood stains are also mixed with sealer & applied by spray.
- Wood stains is an interior product A dye solution and should never be tried for exteriors (as the colour would fade).
- Wood stain coat should never be sanded as it will be removed completely.
- If lighter shade of any wood stain is desired, it can be diluted with a PU Thinner and applied reducing the number of strokes.
- Berger Wood stains come in 11 beautiful rich shades, and are packed in zero-loss aluminum bottles.

Sanding: Along the grains always. Never cross grains.

Don'ts



Cross grain sanding leads to veeners grains being damages
